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European Angiology Days (Angiology and Vascular Medicine are synonymous in Europe) take place yearly, during the weekend on late November and early December. The 21st edition will take place Web Live on 29th November-1st December 2024. europeanangiologysdays.net

They represent the yearly appointment for the specialists in vascular diseases and the ones interested in Angiology/Vascular medicine, in its different areas of expertise.

Highly qualified multidisciplinary contributions, in an open and collaborative vision.

The aim is enhancing and updating knowledge also identifying areas and innovative ways for daily practice as well for action on social impact of health.

They combine up-date on last research reports, review on clinical main open points and, following the VAS view on science, relevant topics on prevention, equity and social determinants.

During the event, Lessons and Sessions are held ranging from the molecular basis of diseases to the most advanced diagnostic techniques and therapies. Beside these, contributions, discussions and workshops on concrete proposals and projects to improve the quality of training in this area, such as public health care organization in vascular disease are planned.

Although VAS is a European scientific foundation, European Angiology Days involve both the VAS International Consortium and the International Networks, becoming over the years an international relevant event.

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In the last edition, 90 European and International experts contributed as Speakers or Chairpersons, from over 20 European countries and from USA, Australia, Canada, Singapore, Argentina, Columbia, Iran, Nigeria.

A fixed appointment from 2020 are also the two prestigious Honorary Awards, the Prof Gustav Born's for Research (endorsed also by the William Harvey Research Institute and the WH Foundation) and the Prof Klaus Breddin's for Education in Angiology/Vascular Medicine.

Nominations are open on the website for the 4th Edition.

Awards for the VAS International Academy (Teaching Panel and Centres of Excellence), for the VAS European Fellowship of Excellence, for the VAS European in Training Fellowship and the European Master certification are given in the last day of the Event.

Abstracts will have a relevant role and will receive three nominations: the Best Oral Presentation, the Best Poster and (new) the Best Student's Abstract.

To summarize, an event to join competences, creativities, energies with the aim to enforce the impact of vascular medicine and knowledge on vascular diseases, as chances of innovation on our everyday practice in clinics, in research and in education.
